

# Warren County Philanthropic Partnership Spring 2009 Grantmaking Fact Sheet

### **Spring 2009 Grant Summary**

- The Warren County Philanthropic Partnership received \$131,604.00 in County Endowment Funds.
- 75% of this award will be granted to non-profit and charitable organizations in the county.
- 30 Spring 2009 grant applications were received with projects totaling \$1,353,840.00.
- 18 grants were awarded to not-for-profits located in 7 communities and 5 county wide.
- The grant awards leveraged \$571,024.57 in total project spending.
- The grant awards are broadly distributed across areas of interest including Arts, Culture & Humanities, Education, Human Services, Public & Social Benefit, Health, and Environment & Animals.
